WHAT SHOULD I EXPECT?

WHAT SHOULD I PREPARE?

For ALL STUDENTS

In addition to the requirements listed below, students should have a few additional pieces in case the faculty ask to see something else (bring your book!).

For High School Seniors

Seniors who are entering their audition season should bring the material that they plan to use for their college auditions. Song and monologue cuts should be based on the requirements of the schools they are applying to.



For All Other Grades

■ Two songs from the musical theatre and/or rock repertoire:

Please choose songs of contrasting styles Songs should be memorized and have either 16 or 32 bar cuts Music should be double-sided in a 3 ring binder, and cuts should be clearly marked for the pianist.

• One monologue, your choice of classical or contemporary:

Monologue should be memorized Monologue should be age appropriate Monologue should be approximately one minute in length.
