

ArtsBridge Audition Workshop Fall 2023 Acting & Musical Theater

WHAT SHOULD I EXPECT?

The first day will begin with a short meet and greet. Students will be split into small groups for classes with each faculty member.

WHAT SHOULD I PREPARE?

For ALL STUDENTS

In addition to the requirements listed below, students should have a few additional pieces in case the faculty ask to see something else (bring your book!).

Bring 3 copies of your headshot & resume. Headshots and resumes should be stapled back-to-back.

For High School Seniors

Seniors who are entering their audition season should bring the material that they plan to use for their college auditions. Song and monologue cuts should be based on the requirements of the schools to which they are applying.

For Non-Seniors

Two songs from the musical theater and/or pop-rock repertoire (MT students only)

- Please choose songs that show contrast
- Songs should be memorized and approximately one minute in length
- Music and cuts should be clearly marked for the pianist and in a 3-ring binder

Two contrasting Monologues

- Monologues should be memorized
- Monologues should be age appropriate
- Monologues should be approximately one minute in length
