WHAT SHOULD I PREPARE?

For ALL STUDENTS

In addition to the requirements listed below, students should have a few additional pieces in case the faculty ask to see something else (bring your book!).

Bring 3 copies of your headshot & resume. Headshots and resumes should be stapled back-to-back.

What to wear: Dress in clothing that you can comfortably move in. You do not need to dress formally/ in audition attire.

For High School Seniors

Seniors who are entering their audition season should bring the material that they plan to use for their college auditions. Song and monologue cuts should be based on the requirements of the schools to which they are applying.

For Non-Seniors

Two songs from the musical theater and/or pop-rock repertoire (MT students only. Actors should prepare to bring whatever song they will be using in auditions.)

- o Please choose songs that show contrast
- o Songs should be memorized and approximately one minute in length
- o Music and cuts should be clearly marked for the pianist and in a 3-ring binder

Two contrasting monologues

- Monologues should be memorized
- Monologues should be age appropriate
- Monologues should be approximately one minute in length
